On the occasion of the Special Survey No.2 being held on the "COLOMB" in September/November last, the vessel's bottom was partly examined on a hard, and a notation was assigned of S.S.No.2-19 subject to the bottom being examined in dry dock at the first convenient opportunity.

In the case of the "PLESSIS", the Special Survey No.2, due March, 1919, was held on the hull in November 1919, nothing was done in regard to the survey of the machinery.

The Quebec Surveyor now forwards a letter from the Owners of these vessels stating that they have decided to dispense with the services of the Society as the benefits derived do not warrant the expense incurred.

The Classing Committee had the cases of these two vessels before them at their Meeting on the 2nd instant, when it was decided to withdraw the classes and to insert three dots (...) in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
