Nature of Survey First Entry


This vessel was built by Messrs. G.T. Davie & Co., at Lauron, near Quebec, in 1910.

Plans and a First Entry report were received at this Office in May last, and were examined and the Quebec Surveyor was informed that the vessel could be classed 100A— "For Ferry Service" between Quebec and Levis", subject to the vessel being examined in dry dock.

With regard to the equipment the Surveyor states that the vessel is supplied with 60 fathoms of 7/8ths chain cable and one anchor, and several warps, but the anchor and cable have not been tested as required, nor is the size of the cable and the weight of the anchors in accordance with the Rules. The vessel has now been examined in dry dock.

It is therefore submitted the vessel might be classed 100A—"Steel"), "For Ferry Service between Quebec and Levis" with record of survey 10, 11.
