The usual preliminary notice in regard to this survey was sent to the Owners to which no reply was received and in the circumstances an enquiry was made of the Liverpool Surveyors who wrote on the 4th December that letters had been addressed to the Owners on the 12th and 20th November to which no reply had been received, but they had been informed by Mr Richard Hughes that the vessel was running into Goole and arrangements were being made to place her on a slipway at that port or at Hull within the next two or three weeks when the requisite survey would take place. In the circumstances the Committee agreed to the survey being postponed subject to this proposal


