In April last the Surveyors at Grimsby recommended that the boiler furnaces should be again examined before the end of June '15.

On the 13th July the Owners were informed that if the new boiler which it was understood was ready, was not fitted forthwith, arrangements must be made for a further examination of the furnaces of the existing boiler.

No reply was received, and on the 11th August the Grimsby Surveyors stated that they had been unable to make any arrangements with the Owners in the matter.

On the 13th ultimo the Owners were informed that definite arrangements must be made for the furnaces to be examined without delay, or the vessel would lose her class.

No reply has been received; and upon the case being submitted to the Classing Committee on the 7th instant, it was decided to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a red line ( 9.15 ) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been so informed.
