
Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 20th instant forwarding a copy of a letter addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Belfast respecting the bower anchors for the Single Screw Sloops "PENTSTEMON" and "PETUNIA", I beg to acquaint you that a letter has been received from the Society's Surveyors stating that the Builders have been advised that the Admiralty do not approve of the anchor No. 20564, weighing 20 cwts. 3 qr. 16 lb. instead of 22 cwt. as required by the specification. The Builders state that this anchor will not be put on board either vessel and that they await the Makers' instructions in regard to its return.

The Surveyors add that as these anchors have been supplied by the Admiralty it is presumed that a new anchor will be forwarded to replace the one not approved of, and I shall be glad if you will be so good as to arrange for the matter to receive attention.
