I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th  
instant respecting the Anchors supplied for H.M. Sloops "PENTSTEMON"  
and "PETUNIA". It is noted that the Admiralty do not approve of  
Anchor No. 20564 weighing 20cwts 3qrs 6lbs instead of 22cwt  
required by the Specification.

The Builders have been advised accordingly and now state that  
the anchor will not be put on board either vessel and that they  
follow the makers instructions regarding its return.

As these anchors have been supplied by the Admiralty it is pre-  
sumed that a new anchor will be forwarded to replace the one not  
approved of.

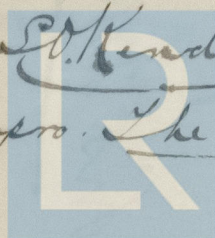
The signed Invoice and Anchor Certificates are enclosed for
