Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant on the case of the steamer "OPLAND", and with regard to this matter, I beg to state, that the contents of your letter of the 20th January last, regarding the manner in which the watertight doors cut in the watertight boiler room bulkhead should be fitted, in order to render the vessel eligible for classification, was sent to the Builders on the 23rd January last, and to the Owner on the 10th instant; and I am today in receipt of an answer from him, in which he says, that he also once received information from the Fevigs Jernskibshyggeri regarding this matter, and that he had written to the Captain of the vessel on this case, but that he had not yet received an answer, which he thinks is caused by the fact, that the steamer was ordered for China.

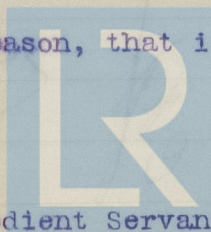
He states further that he will again write to the Master, requesting him as soon as possible, to see that the matter in question is carried out, and to have it confirmed by a Lloyd's Agent. -(The Lloyds Surveyors are in this country, as a rule, turned Lloyd's Agents.)-

He supposes it will take a long time before the matter in question can be put in order for the reason, that it takes the mail long time in reaching Japan.
