Sir.

In reply to your letter of the 20th inst. I beg to state that the following hawsers were supplied to the SS 'Opland', viz. (1) 75 fms of $3\frac{3}{4}$ Steel Wire in lieu of stream chain.

(2) 90 fms of $3\frac{3}{4}$ Steel Wire Tawline.

(3) Two hawsers of 90 fms each of $2\frac{3}{4}$ Steel Wire in lieu of 6' hemp.

all as specified in form at foot of Report.

There was also supplied, as stated in body of Report, 90 fms of 6' Manila and 90 fms of 5' Manila in lieu of two hawsers of 90 fms each of 5' Manila or Hemp, thus completing the hawsers required by Table 22.

This last item was detached from the remainder as there was insufficient space in the form at foot of Report.
