Sir,

J am in receipt of your letter of the 6th. inst. on first entry report No. 457 on the new steamer "Opland", and with regard to this case, J beg to state, that the purpose of the two openings in the boilerroom bulkhead is for the purpose of passing coals from a temporary fitted bunker in tween deck to the bunkers, the doors are made tight as the bolts are pitched 3 1/2". Such doors were also fitted to the steamers "Kamor" and "Providence".

The 75 fathoms of 3 3/4" steel wire were taken onboard at Fevig, but as the test certificate had not arrived, J did not state, that J had examined it, but forgot to mention in the report that it should be seen with the rest of the equipment, that was to be taken onboard at Middlesbro.

The breadth of the garboard strake is 42 1/2".
