Dear Sir,


I am in receipt of your communication dated 1st June with regard to the steam trawler "OITO DE SETEMBRO" and report No. 1206 and note what you state with regard to filling in condition of various parts of the vessel in the spaces provided for this purpose but did not do so on Report No. 1206 in view that I had already done so on report No. 1192, but on future occasions will act as instructed.

With regard to the omission of mentioning that sea connections were examined, I beg to state that your conclusion is correct as all sea connections were opened out, thoroughly cleaned, personally examined and after being ground in, were reclosed.
