I beg to enclose a tracing of the lap-welded Steel Masts as fitted to the S.S. "Strentham". These Masts were made by Stewart & Lloyd of Glasgow and this tracing should have been supplied & submitted sooner - so far as I know they were not inspected by a surveyor to the Society in the makers works - but they look a good job. This may recall some correspondence as to Fees charged for the inspection of similar masts by the same Makers & to the objection made as to their Fees - by the Dublin Dockyard Co. The plan showing the riveted Masts might be cancelled & this one substituted.
