In reply to your letter of the 30th June regarding the case of the steamers "HOPATCONG" and "PROVINCETOWN", I have to advise you that a letter was received from the U.S. Shipping Board dated 27th May with a request that the classification of these two vessels might be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book.

The attention of the Shipping Board had been called to the fact that the freeboards assigned by the Committee had not been correctly marked on the vessels' sides and that the classification of these vessels was conditional upon this being done.

In view of the reply received from the Shipping Board, no further steps have been taken in regard to the matter here.
