Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to Captain Noal's call at this Office yesterday relative to the proposal which is under consideration for classing the Twin Screw Steamer "CENAMIC" with this Society, I beg to inform you that the matter of the fee for the survey for classification has been under consideration today, and I have pleasure to say that the Committee will be prepared, in the special circumstances of this case, to agree to a fee of £150.0.0. for the survey of the hull and machinery of this vessel with a view to classification.

It will of course be understood that the above fee does not include the fee for Freeboard assignment, and this will therefore be an additional charge.

I shall be glad if you will be good enough to let me know when you have arrived at a final decision in the matter, it having been pointed out to Captain Noal that, if you desire to proceed with the survey, he would arrange for the necessary plans of the vessel to be submitted to this Office for the Committee's consideration.
