With reference to your letter of the 11th instant addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby relative to the steam trawler "VENTURE", I am directed to acquaint you that the case of this vessel received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, and in view of the fact that it is not your intention to complete the Second Special Survey No.1, which became due so long ago as April 1923, the Committee regret that they have no alternative but to expunge the class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary surveys and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee with a view to the re-instatement of the class.
