The Second Special Survey No.1, which became due in April 1923, was partly held in August 1923 by the examination of the bottom and rudder in drydock.

In June last, the Owner informed the Grimsby Surveyors that he was unable to stop the vessel for the time, and asked to be allowed to defer the completion of the survey until about the end of August, when the vessel would undergo her annual refit.

The Grimsby Surveyors have now forwarded a letter from the Owner, stating that owing to the general depression of the fishing industry he must ask for the withdrawal of the vessel from class.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 19th instant, decided to expunge the class with a red line (~~8.24~~), indicating non-compliance with the Rules, and the Owner has been informed accordingly.
