The Special Survey (equal to a Half Time Survey) which became due on this Wood Schooner in September last has been partly held, and the Seattle Surveyor recommended in December last that this inspection should be completed before she again proceeded to sea.

The same Surveyor stated in June last that the vessel had changed hands, and that he was unable to make any arrangements with the new Owner regarding the outstanding survey and repairs, and in the circumstances the Owner was informed that the vessel's class would be expunged from the Register Book unless arrangements were made for the Special Survey to be completed forthwith.

The Seattle Surveyor now states that from a personal interview with the Owner he is of opinion that it is not his intention to keep the vessel in class, and in these circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case again before them on Friday, the 8th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (8.24), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
