Dear Sir,

H. I have to acquaint you that the wood schooner "BIANCA" was classed in January, 1920 subject to the bower anchors being replaced by others of correct weight and test. The Owners have now informed the Seattle Surveyors that the vessel is leaving Delagoa Bay for Dunedin. In the circumstances I have to inform you that the bower anchors on board this vessel require to be replaced by anchors of proper weight and test as required by Table 30, letter "V" and that if stockless anchors are supplied these should be increased one fourth in weight above that given in Table 30 as compensation for dispensing with stocks.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case attention and let me know in due course what is done in the matter.
