As difficulties have been experienced in regard to carrying out the surveys on these vessels, the matter has from time to time been referred to the Genoa Surveyors, who have recently had an interview with the Owner.

The Owner states that, while appreciating the interest which the Society has taken to synchronise the dates of surveys with those of the Registro Italiano, he finds that he can retain the British Corporation class at a much smaller cost than that of this Society, and he is reluctantly compelled to renounce the classification of Lloyd's Register.

It is submitted that in these circumstances the classes of the ships should be withdrawn from the Register Book, and (...) inserted, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
