D. I am favoured with your letter of the 17th instant, and note what you say regarding the classification of the steamers "ASTER", "GIGLIO" and "PRIMULA", owned by Mr. Edward Mazza, of Savona; and with reference thereto I think it well to inform you that during the past few days an arrangement has been made between the Registro Italiano and this Society by which vessels may retain the dual classification of Lloyd's Register and the Registro Italiano on much better terms than those previously existing, and the advantage of retaining the dual classification is of course very great.

In these circumstances it is thought that Mr. Mazza may be induced to retain the classification of his vessels with this Society as well as with the Registro Italiano, and I have requested the Society's Surveyors at Genoa to call upon you on the subject.
