Withdrawal of class

The Newcastle Surveyors recently reported that they had examined this vessel in drydock and that the bottom had been cleaned and coated.

The Landing Edge of the garboard strake on the port side amidships was reported to be set up, but as the rivetting and caulking were sound nothing further was done and the Owners stated that they did not desire to continue the classification of the vessel.

This statement has now been confirmed by the Owners.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
