With reference to the weight of cables for the S. S. "Mayagar" Leith Report N^o 10.107, mentioned in your classing letter of the 13th inst. I beg to state that I informed the Builders that the cables were irregular as regards weight and length, and that in future Cables must conform to the Rules. I did not however take any further action seeing that the total weight was in excess, and the length under 1 fathom in excess of the Rules. In checking the wire hawseers I found the certificates were not in accordance with the Rules, and enclose copy of a letter received from the makers
