I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant enclosing the First Entry Report on the Steamer "SAINT LOUIS", and note that you say in regard to the completion of the survey.

With reference to the Builders request to be furnished with a certificate of classification to be placed before the Government Commission on the 22nd instant, I have to acquaint you that in the case of the sister vessel "SAINT JOSEPH", Nantes Report No.666, the Society's Surveyor at his request was authorised to issue a provisional certificate on Form F when the survey was completed, and I have therefore to request that as soon as the inspection is completed to your satisfaction you will issue such a certificate in this instance.
