The Special Survey No.3 of this trawler became due in June 1922, and to complete the inspection the engine and boiler space, bunkers, pumps and peaks require to be examined and the cables ranged.

In January last the Classing Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to complete the survey at the next drydocking, which would take place in June 1924.

The Grimsby Surveyors wrote on the 31st ultimo that the Owners stated the survey would be completed at the end of this year. They were instructed to inform the Owners that if the vessel was to retain her class the remaining requirements of the Special Survey must be carried out now.

The Owners have now stated to the same Surveyors that they are not in a financial position to incur the expense of opening up the necessary spaces for the purpose of examination, and in the circumstances can only place the case in the hands of the Committee.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 26th instant, when it was decided to expunge the class with a red line (8.24), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
