Action has been deferred from time to time and on the 22nd January last a proposal to complete the survey at the next dry docking in June, 1924 was agreed to.

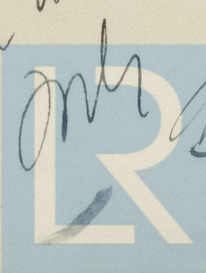
The Grimsby Surveyors now state they have been informed by the Owners that the special survey will be completed at the end of this year, which proposal in their opinion merits favourable consideration.
