The Hull of this vessel has been built under the survey of the Society's Surveyor at Great Yarmouth, for classification with this Society. The Engines have been built under the survey of the British Corporation Surveyors at the works of Messrs Brown Bros & Co., Ltd. Edinburgh, and the Certificate issued by that Society for these Engines is attached herewith. The Boiler was built under the survey of this Society's Surveyors at the works of Messrs. T. Sudron & Co., Ltd., of Stockton.

The London Surveyors now state that the British Corporation have surveyed the installation of the machinery on board in accordance with the arrangement made with the Admiralty, and the trial trip has been under their supervision.

As it is provided in the Committee's circular letter dated the 16th March 1918, that in such cases as this, this Society will issue the Machinery Certificate with the notification L.M.C. with date in Red, it is submitted that this vessel is now eligible for the record of L.M.C. 7-18
