The above mentioned vessels, which were built  
under Special Survey during the war for the Government, and  
belonged to the "Kil" class, originally held the character  
"A1 - For Government Service".

Alterations were subsequently effected with a view  
to the class "100A1" being assigned.

They have now been sold to German Owners, who do  
not propose to continue the classification, and Mr. Dykes, the  
Society's Principal Surveyor for Germany, explains that this  
decision is due to the difference between the Society's scale  
of fees and that of the Germanischer Lloyd, which latter is,  
of course, in Marks.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who  
had the cases before them on Tuesday, 13th instant, decided to  
give instructions for the character of each vessel to be  
withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted  
in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners'  
request.
