This "KIL" Class vessel was built in 1918 under the survey of the British Corporation, being similar to other vessels constructed under this Society's supervision to plans mutually approved by Lloyd's Register and the British Corporation and classed A1 "For Government Service".

The vessel came under the Society's survey in August 1920 1920, when considerable alterations were made to render her suitable for carrying cargo, and she was then classed 100A1 with this Society.

The question has now been raised as to when the Special Survey No.1 should be reckoned to become due, and the Surveyors were asked to state whether the survey held by them when the vessel was converted for cargo purposes might be considered as a Special Survey No.3, in order that the Special Survey No. 1 might be dated from the completion of the survey.

The Surveyors now state that they are of opinion that the survey held by them could be considered as a Special Survey No.3.

It is therefore submitted that a notation of S.S. No.3 might be made against this vessel's name in the Register Book.
