Dear Sir,

A. With reference to the Liverpool first entry report No.78433 on the Boom Defence Vessel "B.D.20" I have to inform you that an account has to-day been rendered to the Admiralty for the fees due for the Survey during construction of this vessel viz:- £24. 10. 0. and also for the fee of £5. 5. 0. for the damage survey held in consequence of collision with the S.S."BRITISH ISLES".

I shall be glad if you will see that these fees are duly entered in the Liverpool Rough Fee and Debit Books.

As in the case of the Sister Vessel "B.D.19" (see my letter of the 6th November, last,) no fee is chargeable for the installation on board of the Donkey Boilers, the total fee of £8. 8. 0. having been paid by the Boiler and Winch Makers.

I have at the same time to add that it is concluded that the inner surface of the bottom in the boiler space is cemented as in the sister vessel, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyors, and let me know whether this is so.
