Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steam Trawler "SERIEUX", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration the correspondence which the Society's Office at Paris has had with your good selves in the matter, from which the Committee note that you wish the Classification to be retained until it expires.

In reply, I have to point out that the Special Survey No. 3 prescribed by the Rules became due in February, 1918, and has not yet been completed, so that under the Rules, the vessel has become liable to lose her class.

In these circumstances, the Committee regret there is no alternative but to give instructions for the class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
