Dear Sir,

Reverting to previous correspondence respecting the case of the s. Trawler "SERIEUX", I beg to enclose copies of correspondence which I have had with Messrs. Scotto, Ambrosino & Pugliese the present Owners of the vessel.

It will be observed that the work required to be done as a condition of Classification in LLOYD'S REGISTER Book is stated to have been carried out under the inspection of the Bureau Veritas, and I think it must be assumed from the Owners' letter of the 25th ultimo that they do not desire to retain LLOYD'S REGISTER Classification.
