The Steam Superheater Elements are composed of solid drawn
steel tubes and are fitted with spigot flanges.

Twenty-one elements, representing about 10 % of the
total, were tested in my presence by hydraulic pressure to 1,000
pounds per square inch and were found satisfactory.

The elements are, so far as can be seen, sound and free from
defects, and are suitable for a working pressure of 180 pounds
per square inch.
