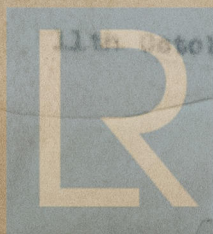
These wood vessels, which are all overage, special survey (equal to a full size survey) and Water Tube boiler survey, have been lying up for some time past, and the late owners furnished the usual undertaking at the beginning of May.

On Tuesday, the 9th instant, the Classing Committee had before them a letter from the Society's Agents surveyors stating that the vessels had been sold to Signor Arrigo Medugno, who writes that in view of the impossibility of again placing them in commission, it is his intention to sell them for demolition.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee decided to give instructions for the vessels' classes to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (70, 23.) in each case, indicating non-compliance with the Society's rules.
