The First Special Survey No. 1 of this vessel became due in September last and the survey of the screw shaft in September, 1922.

The steamer has been laid up at Philadelphia for two years, and on the 9th instant, the Owners, in a letter addressed to the Society's New York Office, requested the withdrawal of her classification from the Register Book.

The case received the consideration of the American Committee on Tuesday, 20th ultimo, when it was decided to withdraw the character of the vessel from the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
