In reply to your letter of 6th instant we have to state that the Clarkson Waste Heat boilers fitted to the motorevessel "CALGAROLITE" were ordered by the shipbuilders to be constructed under Special Survey of this Society and also that of Board of Trade. We regret that, not having been made in this district, we have no record of the identification marks.

We would mention that the safety valves of these boilers were adjusted under steam to a pressure of 105 lbs. per square inch and that the screw lift stop valves were converted to non return.
