In accordance with last paragraph of Circular 1533 we have to inform you that the motor vessel "CALGAROLITE", Messrs. Furness Shipbuilding Co's No.131, Middlesbrough Rpt. No.13754, has two Clarkson Waste Heat boilers 4'-6" dia. x 8'-5½" high which are so connected as to be able to work the steam auxiliaries in engine room.

These boilers are each designed to evaporate 1000 lbs. of water per hour into steam at 100 lbs. per square inch but we have no figures available for the heating surface.
