deck to be fitted in No. 4 hold.

I return herewith two copies of the above plan submitted with Mr. Cairns' letter of the 17th instant, and with regard thereto I have to state that the arrangements as shewn and amended will be approved, provided they be carried out to their satisfaction. I have also to state that the beams of the lower deck have been approved on the assumption that cargo will not be carried above these beams at the same time as chilled meat is suspended from the same.

With regard to the main deck beams it should be noted that if it is intended to carry cargo above these beams at the same time as chilled meat is suspended from the same, these beams, also the pillars and girders supporting them, will require to be re-inforced. It is suggested that you should confer with the Builders with a view to a plan being submitted shewing their proposal in regard to this.
