I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, enclosing a copy of one from Messrs. Bethlehem Shipbuilding Company respecting the Emergency Lighting Circuit proposed for their Yard No. 4327, and note the contents.

The matter has received careful consideration, and I have to state that no exception will be taken to a small number of emergency lights in the engine and boiler rooms being supplied at 220 volts. It is understood they will be plainly marked to distinguish them from the 110 volt lighting points and that none of these fittings will be outside the spaces mentioned.

It is noted that fuse and cable sizes will be submitted later.
