It is not entirely clear to the writer what is  
the horse power of the H.P. turbine but from your letter of  
the 16th July I understand that it will not exceed 2500 HP  
at 5500 RPM.

Subject to the above being correct and provided  
the forgings be tested in accordance with the Rules and spec-  
ifications shown on the plan, and provided the arrangements  
as shown be carried out in accordance with the Rules and to  
the satisfaction of the Surveyor, and be satisfactorily tried  
at full power upon completion, the same will be approved.

copy for our files.
