

Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you that Messrs. Grace & Co, Valparaiso, state that the new tug and barge launch "TOFO" was delivered to the Bethlehem Steel Company at Coquimbo on the 1th June last and that the anchors and chains, as well as the certificates were delivered to the latter firm shortly afterwards. Messrs. Grace & Co. also state they are under the impression that the marks of the vessel's equipment were compared with the certificates of test by your good selves at Coquimbo, and as this was required to be done in order to render the vessel eligible for the figure "1" in her class for equipment, the Committee will be much obliged if you will kindly state whether the anchors and chains have been examined and the marks thereon compared with the certificates of test. If this be the case I shall be obliged if you will kindly forward particulars of the same to this Office and I enclose a form for reporting the same.

I have to add that all fees and expenses in connexion with this examination will fall to be borne by the Owners or their representatives and should accordingly
