
Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 17th instant relative to the equipment of the barque "TOFO", I beg to acquaint you that in order to admit of the figure "1" for equipment being assigned to this vessel it will be necessary for the anchors and chain cables to be inspected and to be verified with the Certificates of Test after having been placed on board.

If this can be done at the port of Valparaiso, the Society's Surveyor at that port will be able to undertake the necessary inspection, and I am accordingly communicating with him with a view to his ascertaining from Messrs. W.R. Grace & Co. there what arrangements can be made in the matter.

With regard to the Certificates you refer to, I may say that the Certificate for the Boiler No.193 should be forwarded to the Owners.

The Certificates of Test for the anchors and chain cables will require to be produced for the information of the Surveyor when inspecting and verifying the articles of equipment
