Equipment

This vessel was recently classed A- "For Service between Coquimbo and Kruzgrande".

The Plymouth Surveyor now reports that he has made a preliminary examination of the equipment, which is intended to be placed on board this vessel.

The cable to be supplied is as follows:— 242 feet (40-1/3 fathoms) of proper size, weight and test and 92 feet (15-1/3 fathoms) of non-statutory test. The length of cable approved is 60 fathoms.

It will be observed that the cable supplied is 26 feet or 4-1/3 fathoms shorter than the length approved. for the consideration of the Committee whether

It is submitted the cable might be approved in this instance and action deferred until the cable has been placed on board and examined.
