Referring to your letter of the 21st of May & 30th of June, regarding the surveys overdue on the Steam Trawlers "PETREL" "THAIS" & "TIBURON", we are at last in receipt of a letter from the Italian Minister of Transport Marittimi & Ferroviari, at Rome dated the 8th inst., in which he states that these vessels have been passed over to the Minister of Marine, & that they now form part of the Italian Navy. The latter states that under these circumstances, there is no longer occasion for these vessels to remain classed in any Register of Classification. Please therefore withdraw their class with the usual three dots.
