" In answer to the contents of your letter & verbal communication of the 27th ult., we beg leave to inform you that as the British Corporation are the Agents for the Registro Nazionale , and as we are obliged to have our ships classed with the latter, our Company has decided to withdraw the class of its vessels from Lloyd's Register


