My Dear Mr. Garelli,

We hear that your Company's steamer "VERONA"
has returned to Belfast with extensive damages to her main
engines. Our Surveyors, advise us, however, that the
captain states their services are not required as the
owners propose to drop the class.

I am very sorry to hear this and trust this action
has not been definitely decided on. In any case I think it
might be well to point out that there is nothing to be gained
by abandoning the class until at least the vessel becomes
due for Special Survey and further that the inspection of
the present repairs by the Society's Surveyors at Belfast
could seem to be very desirable.
