Gentlemen,

I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Belfast report that the steamer "VERONA" belonging to the Soc.di Nav. a Vap. Italia, has arrived at that port recently with extensive damage to her main engines. The Captain states that no survey is required from the Society's officers as the Owners intend to drop the class, but I shall be glad if you will be good enough to see the Owners of the vessel, which as you are aware was built under the Special Survey of the Society in 1908, with a view to inducing them to give instructions to their Representative at Belfast so that the repairs to this vessel may be effected under the Surveyors' supervision in order to the retention of her classification in the Society's Register Book.
