Herewith enclosed I beg to submit for consideration a test certificate No 7124 Cardiff, for the stream anchor supplied to Messrs Workman Clark & Co. St. No 271. "Verona". It will be observed that this anchor is 28 lbs lighter than required by the Rules.

It would appear that two kedge anchors ^{c 12 lb} 12.0.0 and ^{c 9 lb} 12.0.7 have been supplied to this vessel and in view of this fact the stream anchor in question is submitted for approval.
