The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

Nature of Survey

The class is subject to cargo battens being fitted in Nos. 3 & 5 holds and part of No. 1 hold at the first opportunity and to (a bower anchor and 45 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

The BRISTOL Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and decks, casings examined and found in order.

The items, as above, have not been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of docking survey 4.42 subject as above.
