Dear Sirs,

M. I was duly favoured with your letter of the 31st ultimo respecting the vessel commenced by the Thames Iron Works and now purchased by you in an incomplete condition, and I note that you have now decided to commence the rivetting up of this vessel and desire her to be classed as originally contemplated, viz:- Al "For Service on the Bosphorus and Sea of Marmora".

It is noted that the vessel will be riveted up at the Thames Iron Works and afterwards launched and towed round to your yard for completion, also that the machinery is being completed at your yard and is now being erected.

In the circumstances the Society's Surveyors are being authorised to proceed with the special survey of this vessel in accordance with your request.

At the same time, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether or not you desire the Society's Surveyors to certify that the Owners' specification has been complied with, as was originally contemplated, for which special
