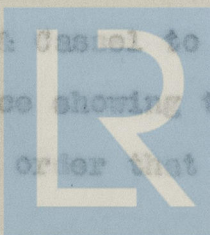

Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter bearing date 18th (?) instant, and to explain that the signing by you of the usual form of request for Special Survey, enclosed herewith, would of course not involve you in any liability for the payment of the fees unless the present condition of the vessel is found to be such that she can be completed to the satisfaction of the Committee with a view to classification in Lloyd's Register Book, as otherwise the survey would not be carried further. I think that on this understanding you will have no objection to give the requisite undertaking to pay the classification survey fees, so that the Committee may be in a position to authorise the Society's Surveyors to continue the survey of the vessel. Whether the Society's Surveyors verify the carrying out of the specification is a matter which would be entirely at your option.

I shall be much obliged if you will kindly request Messrs. Fuller, Horsey & Castel to furnish this office with satisfactory evidence showing that you are the actual owners of the vessel, in order that the Rules of this
