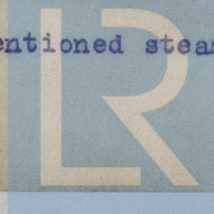

Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee of this Society have given their careful consideration to the remarks in your letter of the 27th October regarding the classification in the Society's Register Book of the vessels of your fleet.

The Committee regret to note the decision which has been arrived at by your goodselves that your steamers which are engaged in the Mediterranean Trade are no longer to retain their classification in Lloyd's Register, and in accordance with your wishes they have given instructions for the classes of the following vessels to be withdrawn from the Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, namely - s.s. "ABBAZIA", "AVENTINO", "BRIONI", "BUCOVINA", "CAMPIDOGGIO", "CARNIOLIA", "CELIO", "CLEOPATRA", "DALMATIA", "FRIULI", "GALICIA", "GASTEIN", "GIANICOLO", "GORIZIA", "GRAZ", "HELOUAN", "LEOPOLIS", "MERANO", "NETTUNO", "PALACKY", "PALATINO", "PRAGA", "QUIRINALE", "REMO", "SARAJEVO", "SEMIRAMIS", "TRENTO" and "VIENNA".

I am directed to add that the Committee are very pleased to note your desire that the decision which you have arrived at as regards the above mentioned steamers shall not
